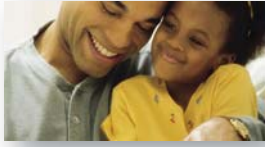


MCIR BMI - Sample Clinic Flow



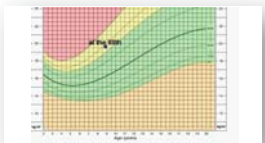
Patient Arrives for Patient Visit: Hand the patient the Behavioral and Health Survey developed for the patient's age group.



Patient in Waiting Room: Patient fills out Behavioral and Health Survey.



Patient Measurements: Collect the Behavioral and Health Survey and proceed to measure height and weigh the patient.



MCIR BMI Data Entry: Enter the patient height and weight into the MCIR BMI. Print off the MCIR BMI patient-specific Clinical Decision Support sheet and BMI Growth Charts. Mark the expected diastolic and systolic blood pressure on the Clinical Decision Support sheet.



Patient Charts: Include the results from Behavioral and Health Survey, Clinical Decision Support sheet, and BMI Growth Charts in the patient chart that is used by the physician in the patient exam room.



Patient in Exam Room: Physician counsels patient based on Behavioral and Health Survey results, Clinical Decision Support sheet, and BMI Growth Chart.



Patient Visit Documentation: Patient information filed in medical chart. Record Clinical Activity in the MCIR BMI if applicable to patient visit.
