Olweus Bullying Prevention Program (OBPP) Schoolwide Guide with DVD/CD

OBPP is used both in individual classrooms and throughout your school. It will be important that you participate at both levels. For the schoolwide effort, this Schoolwide Guide, with DVD/CD is available to provide instructions on how to implement the program in the entire school setting.

OBPP Teachers Guide with DVD/CD -The teacher's guide with DVD/CD serves as the primary program implementation tool for teachers and other classroom staff. It highlights the important role you will play both in the classroom and in schoolwide efforts in preventing and addressing bullying.

Bright Futures, American Academy of Pediatrics 3rd Edition

The authoritative AAP Guidelines for Health Supervision III you've relied on for years is combined with the practical approach Bright Futures delivers. The result: an updated, highly efficient system to help you provide better health care, save time, and keep up with changes in family, communities, and society that impact child's health. Part I is organized into 10 themes common to all stages of child development, with special emphasis on 2 new significant challenges: mental health and healthy weight. Part II focuses on specific guidance for each of 31 age-based health care visits. Each visit enumerates 5 priorities for that visit, including sample questions and discussion points for both parent and child.

Bright Futures: Guidelines for Health Supervision of Infants, Children, and Adolescents, 3rd Edition Kit

It includes current forms and materials that relate to preventive health supervision and health screening for infants, children and adolescents.

Asthma Care Training: Ages 7-12

This training is for families and children with asthma to improve their knowledge, decision-making skills and self-management behaviors. Children and families attend 3 group sessions separately, then come together to share knowledge. Program has been validated through formal research as an effective patient education program and recognized by the CDC. This resource includes 3 instructor manuals, 2 sets of reusable material and materials for 10 families.

Skillstreaming – New Strategies and Perspectives for Teaching Prosocial Skills: Grades 6-12.

This training addresses the social skill needs of students who display aggression, immaturity, withdrawal, or other problem behaviors. This newly revised book offers the most up to date information for implementing the Skillstreaming approach which utilizes modeling, role playing, performance feed-back, and transfer (homework). Students develop competence in dealing with interpersonal conflicts and learn to use self-control. Includes 50 skill lessons, and includes six skill groups: Beginning social skills, advance social skills, dealing with feelings, alternatives to aggression, dealing with stress, and planning skills. This curriculum has also been used within our network of centers by several providers. ***The Elementary Kit is also available.***
