The CDC recommends that all people from six months to 24 years of age get the H1N1 flu shot.

Children under 9 years of age will need two H1N1 flu shots.

Your child cannot get the H1N1 flu from the vaccination.

**CONVENIENT**

Your child can receive the H1N1 flu shot at your school-based/school-linked health center.

You and your family can schedule an appointment to receive your H1N1 flu shot.

It's FREE. There is no cost for the H1N1 flu shot.
